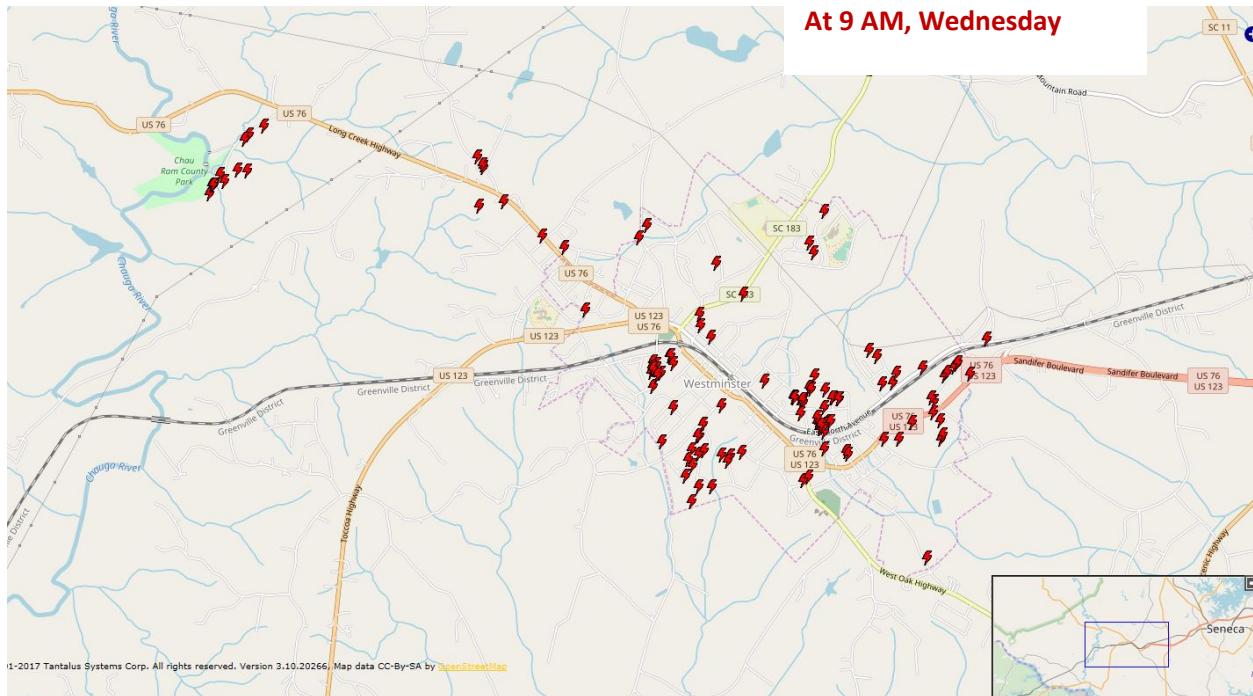


Electrical Outage Information at 9 AM Wednesday September 13th

City electric crews are continuing an “all-out” effort to restore electrical service to service interruptions caused by the passing of the remnants of Hurricane Irma on Tuesday.

Due to our system monitoring being restored at City we are aware of the location of outages still in the system. This morning 105 out of approximately 1500 customers are being reported as service disruptions. We have a general map of active services in which no usage is being recorded and can relate that information to street addresses. (see outage map below)



Rest assured our effort will continue. Work is somewhat slowed from “ regular” restoration work due to the amount of down trees and limb debris that need to be cleared before new cross-arms and poles can be installed.

If your home had damage to the meter base and we cannot connect back, an electrical inspection by Oconee County will be necessary as well as the work being completed by a licensed electrical contractor. The number at Oconee County Inspections is (864) 718-1005.
